Emergency Solutions Grant Program (ESG)

Rapid Rehousing Financial Assistance

- Targeted populations include homeless with a disability as defined by HUD, chronically homeless, and generally homeless.
- We can assist with security deposits, utility arrearages, and utility deposits.

Prevention Financial Assistance

- Targeted populations include those with rental arrearages facing eviction.
- We assist with rent arrearages, security deposits, utility arrearages, and utility deposits.

Weatherization Program

- The goal of the Weatherization Assistance Program is to lower energy costs to the individual thereby freeing up precious income that can be applied toward another living expense or to make paying the high energy bills more attainable through energy efficiency measures.
- Low-income homeowners and renters are provided services such as weather-stripping, caulking, and insulation of attics, walls and crawl spaces.
- An extensive energy audit is performed on each home. We examine and test the efficiency of the heating units in a home, and also test for the amount of carbon monoxide in the ambient air of the home.
- Eligibility for this program is based on the gross income of all household members. Written verification of income and home ownership or rental status is required.

Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF)

- We offer case management services and assistance in accessing all VA benefits as well as community resources.
- We can also provide temporary financial assistance for security deposits, rent payments, rent and utility arrearages, child care, moving expenses, transportation assistance and emergency transitional housing assistance.
- Targeted populations include veterans who are literally homeless and those that are imminently homes (i.e. received eviction notice) who meet our income guidelines.
