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Early Head Start Program

- The Early Head Start Program provides free home visiting services for low-income pregnant women and families with children who are 0-3 years old
- Home visitors provide family centered services that facilitate child development, health, nutrition, preschool readiness, social/emotional health, and support parental roles and self sufficiency
- Socialization with children and families are provided biweekly at several locations

Head Start Program

- The Head Start Program provides free pre-school education programs for low-income children 3-5 years old.
- It also provides family services and health services for children.
- Critical components of the program include family involvement, school readiness, parent education, proper nutritional experiences and health services.
- The Head Start program supports parents in their efforts to nurture and assist in their child's development.
- Family strengths are identified and parents receive guidance to help deal with possible concerns.

Great Start Readiness Program

- The Great Start Readiness Program serves 4 year old children who may be at risk of becoming educationally disadvantaged or who may have special needs
- Child must be at least 4 years old by September 1st of the year they apply
- Services that are provided are: parent involvement, adult-child interaction, active learning, comprehensive developmental screenings, nutritional snacks, developmentally appropriate curriculum, kindergarten readiness and transition activities
